City of Portsmouth Mosquito Control

The Mosquito Control program begins April 13, 2020 in the City of Portsmouth. Crews from Dragon Mosquito Control, Inc. will be checking swamps, salt marshes, woodland pools, ditches, catch basins and other shallow, stagnant water for mosquito larvae. When mosquitoes are found, the following larvicides may be used:

VectoBac (Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis 2.8%)

Natular (spinosad 2.5%)

Fourstar MBG (Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis 3.0% & Bacillus sphaericus 3.0%)

VectoMax FG (Bacillus thuringiensis israelensis 4.5% & Bacillus sphaericus 2.7%)

CocoBear MLO (mineral oil 10%)

BVA 2 Mosquito Larvicide Oil (mineral oil 97%)

A truck mounted sprayer will disperse Merus 3.0 (organic pyrethrins) along roadways. Road spraying will begin in June and may continue into October. It is not possible to predict the schedule for road spraying in advance. The spray schedule is based upon mosquito surveillance data, disease test results and weather conditions.

It is not possible to predict if emergency spraying for Eastern Equine Encephalitis, Jamestown Canyon Virus or West Nile Virus will be necessary. Disease activity occurs later in the summer. A decision to conduct emergency spraying would be made in consultation with Portsmouth City Officials. Further communication will be given if this action is required.
